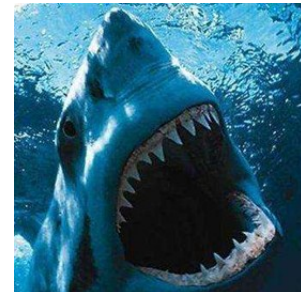
THE HISTORY OF WORDS by Maia Romanowsky and Riley Gold

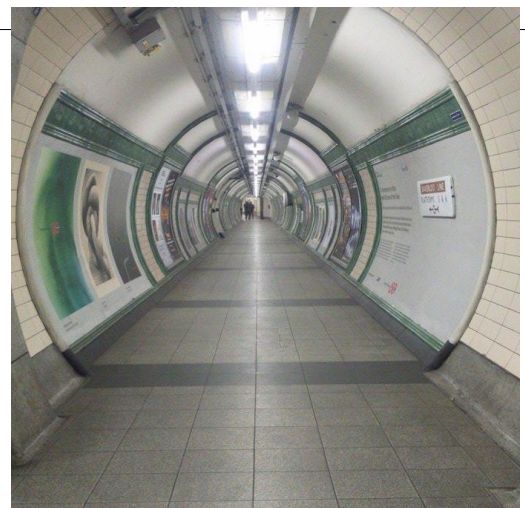

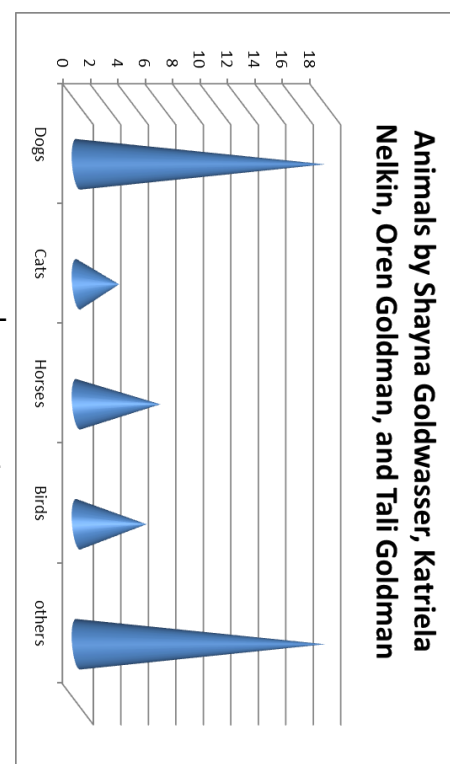

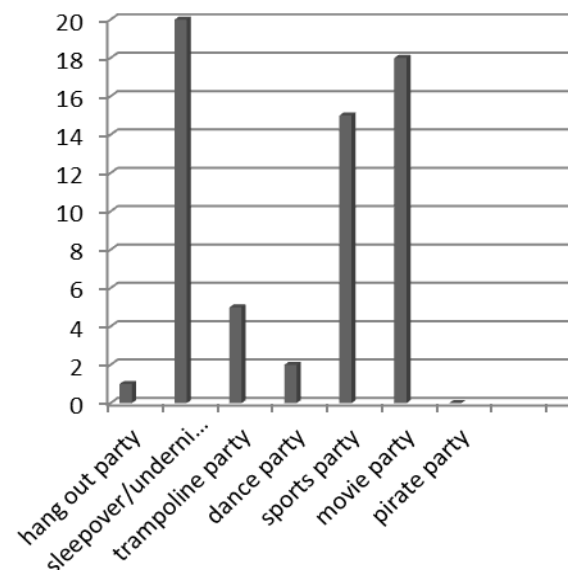
